

Four-Corner Fold

A four-corner fold is useful when you want to compare the characteristics of four topics. The four-corner fold can organize the characteristics of the four topics side by side under the flaps. Similarities and differences between the four topics can then be easily identified.



See how it's done.

1. Fold a **sheet of paper** in half from the top to the bottom. Then, unfold the paper.
2. Fold the top and bottom of the paper to the crease in the center of the paper.
3. Fold the paper in half from side to side. Then, unfold the paper.
4. Using **scissors**, cut the top flap creases made in step 3 to form four flaps..

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
