We agree to honor the terms and conditions listed below:

- The student is expected to pick up the calculator at the beginning of the class period from the assigned location on days when the device is to be used. The teacher will always assume that the student is in possession of the device for the duration of the period and until directed to replace the device in its normal storage position in the classroom.
- The student is expected to report any problems (missing Calculator, low batteries, graffiti, etc.) to the teacher immediately.
- The student is expected to care for the calculator when in possession of it. This includes (but is not limited to) not dropping the device on the floor, not playing games or typing unnecessarily (which wastes batteries), and not writing/drawing on the device.
- The student is expected to return the calculator at the end of the class period or when otherwise directed by the teacher.
- The student is expected to pay the replacement cost (approximately \$100 for each unit) for damaged, lost, or stolen devices. A hold slip will be placed for any monies owed.
- The student is required to turn in his/her cell phone(s) at the beginning of class. If it is discovered that the student did not turn in a cell phone at the beginning of class but has one or more in his/her possession, the phone(s) will be confiscated and turned in to his/her assistant principal.
- The teacher is not responsible for missing, lost, damaged, or stolen cell phones. The student, parents, and/or guardians assume all risks associated with allowing students to bring cell phones (or other electronic devices) to school.
- While the student may be granted at times to use his/her cell phone for academic purposes, I understand that cell phones are not a required supply for physics class.
